Don Glover was an engineer with Hurst starting in 1967. In his time at Hurst he worked on the team that developed many of the products and specialty cars. Stepping away from automotive products, Don was part of the team that created the Jaws of Life – yes, the lifesaving device used by almost every fire department! Basically, if it came from Hurst between 1967 and 1976, Don's fingerprints are probably on it!
