Produced from 1965-71 at the Renault factory in Billancourt, France, it was exported to the U.S. beginning in 1967 and it was the last and best of the line of rear-engine Renaults. It had evolved from the post-war Renault 4CV. The R-10 was an evolution of the boxy R-8 of 1962, which was closely related to the Dauphine, its immediate predecessor. An all-new 956cc inline-four, code-named the Sierra, was introduced with the R-8. It was enlarged to 1108cc for the R-8 Major and it was this engine that carried over to the R-10.

The R-10 was essentially an R-8 that had been In 1965, Rena stretched by eight inches to provide more leg room and a bit more space up front for luggage. Like the R-8, it featured disc brakes on all four wheels, **"It is a luxuriously comfortable sedan that is fun to drive, easy to park and maneuvers like a sports car. Test drive it! disc brakes on all four wheels, which was highly sophisticated equipment for an economy car of its time. Steering was by rack and

pinion, with a relatively quick 3.4 turns from lock to lock. The suspension was fully independent with control arms and coil springs up front and swing axles, radius rods and coil springs in the rear.

The interior was sparsely furnished, though no more so than the Volkswagens, Fiats, Datsuns and other economy cars in its price range. Amenities included reclining bucket seats, dual sun visors, a two-speed heater blower and two-speed windshield wipers. The front windows rolled up and down, but the back windows were of the sliding variety. There was also a somewhat gauche faux-woodgrain overlay on the instrument panel. The sticker price was a low \$1,647.

"The Renault 10 is an economy car that is also outstanding in its price field for many other reasons," the brochures touted. "It is a luxuriously comfortable sedan that is fun to drive, easy to park and maneuvers like a sports car. Test drive it! Re-discover the fun of driving. Discover a new economy in car ownership!"

In 1965, Renault introduced an electric semi-auto-

matic gearbox. Developed and produced by Jaeger, it employed something called a "ferromagnetic coupler" in place of a clutch. This coupler used iron powder, which, when an electromagnet was energized, locked the driving and driven plates of the transmission

together. The gearbox, the three-speed unit from the Dauphine, was controlled by push-buttons on the dash.

The second major change in specification came in 1970, when displacement was increased to 1,289cc. This brought a 17% boost in power, from 48 horsepower to a heady 56. Production of the R-10 ended in 1971 in France, though the model continued to roll off Renault's Spanish assembly lines until 1973. In all, just under 700,000 were produced.

Exterior

Body & Paint:

10) POINTS

This category is based on panel alignment & straightness, body kit (fitment, rarity of product, etc), paint/glass condition, shaving, body part or lighting conversions, wide body, and/or any other custom bodywork.

Suspension:



Type of suspension (static/air/etc). Also taking into consideration: attention to detail, ride height, undercarriage upgrades, fitment and finish of products, powdercoating/plating, install of air components.

Brakes:



The judges are looking for big brake or custom brake upgrades. Are both the front and rear upgraded? Quality and rarity of product? Also taking into consideration any other braking accessories, brake lines, and custom finishes on the braking system.

Wheels & Tires:



This category focuses on the uniqueness, rarity, and fitment of the wheels and tires. Also taking into consideration cleanliness and custom finishes.

Overall Quality:



This category focuses on the overall execution of the vehicle's exterior. Scores will be based on attention to detail, use of color & unique finishes, graphics, quality of finish, accessory lighting, and cleanliness.



Appearance & Performance:



This category focuses on engine bolt-ons, custom fabrication, aspiration (turbo/supercharger/etc), motor swap, use of paint and or custom plating/finishing, cleanliness of wiring, nitrous oxide, accessories.

Overall Execution:



Craftsmanship is key in this category. Judges will evaluate safety upgrades, performance engineering, one-off/custom parts, attention to detail, quality of plating/polishing/finishes, and most importantly level of difficulty (ie motor swap, turbo, shaved bay, wire tuck, rhd or rwd conversions, etc). Interior

Passenger Compartment:

10 POINTS

This category focuses on the seating area - taking into consideration the condition and quality of dash, seats, accessories, unique features, roll cage or roll bar(s), use of fabric/materials, and overall upholstery.

Trunk - 10) POINTS Entertainment vs. Motorsport Theme

This is a progressive judging category which takes into consideration the theme of the vehicle build. In this category, motorsport or performance themed vehicles do not lose points for not including a custom audio/video install.

Audio/Show Car themed vehicles will be scored based on In Car Entertainment, audio install (visual), video sources and tv/monitors, quality/rarity of products, air suspension components installed in cargo area, etc.

Motorsport/Performance themed vehicles will be scored based on fuel cell install, roll cage components in trunk or rear suspension area, suspension components, strut bars, braces, safety equipment, quality/rarity of products, etc.

Overall Quality:

10 POINTS

Attention to detail, use of color/finishes, materials, fitment, cleanliness, fabrication, level of customization.

Show Quality

The Show Quality portion of the scoresheet is a comprehensive look at the build's overall execution and style. These two categories are judged based on the universal 5-star rating system. Those possible 10 stars count as the final 10 points of your overall score.

Originality/Uniqueness:



Rare vehicles or more common vehicles with unique modifications and rare parts will score higher.

Overall Execution:

5 STARS

Overall quality of build. Fitment throughout all aspects of vehicle. Does the vehicle flow? Is it period or era correct? Is it relevant to current trends? Is the vehicle still functional?

The overall score is based on a possible 100 TOTAL POINTS.

LOROUT

Due to the unique format of Carlisle's Import & Performance Nationals, not all vehicles will fit strictly into the official "Judging Standards" score sheet. Vehicles that have been purposely kept stock for restoration or preservation purposes will be judged on slightly different criteria. All drivers must consider that they are competing against a flawless version of their build on a score sheet, rather than against the other competitors in their class, whether the vehicle is stock, subtle, or aggressively modified. Some classes may include both stock and modified vehicles.

Restored and preserved vehicles will be judged on the same visual areas of their vehicles – *Exterior, Engine Compartment, Interior/Trunk, Overall Execution, etc.* Deductions can be given for imperfections in paint/materials, scratches, general dirty upkeep, etc. Further deductions can be given for bolt-ons and custom modifications as well. If you are building a restoration project, you must keep in mind that all aspects of the build must be "period correct" for age of the vehicle. A properly restored vehicle should now once again have the appearance of a show room vehicle from its original production date – with zero or few aftermarket modifications. A preserved vehicle may show some age, but should still overall maintain its factory show room appearance. Replacement parts should be "period correct" and should be OEM equipment.

Deductions and scoring will be weighed accordingly, so that stock (restored and preserved) vehicles that appear in the same classes as modified vehicles, will be considered on a level playing field for placement within the final results. The event judging staff has gone through a training and selection process to be a part of this event.

BRYAN JOSLIN IN HIS 2000 LAND ROVER DISCOVERY II

Publisher of Alloy + Grit Magazine Bryan Joslin describes his passion for Land Rovers as a subliminal affinity, one that can't be pinpointed by a particular time or event. However, a 1987 trip to England is worth noting: he couldn't help but notice the pervasive presence of the off-roaders, shifting his admiration into overdrive.

30 years later and after a move to Doylestown, PA, Joslin has turned his enduring fascination into North America's only independent outlet for all things Land Rover: Alloy + Grit Magazine. The first issue was released last November after three years in development, described by Joslin as a highly tactile product that can't be replicated in the digital space. A growing number of 1,500 subscribers (including a robust percentage hailing from Australia and the UK) receive the magazine quarterly with all-encompassing coverage of the Land Rover lifestyle through an American perspective.

Joslin is the owner of a 2000 Discovery II and a newly purchased 1993 Range Rover that awaits him in Illinois.

Soon, a 2003 Range Rover will be added to his collection which he is currently negotiating. There are two models he'd love to see in his driveway: a 2015 Range Rover Holland & Holland edition (\$245,000 new, only 30 built for the US, comes with a built-in shotgun cabinet in the rear cargo) and a Defender 110 double-cab pickup (diesel with manual gearbox, right-hand drive).

Carlisle Import & Performance Nationals welcomes Joslin and his 2000 Discovery II as part of the Pennsylvania-based ROVERS Club to the fairgrounds. Close to 40 Land Rovers will be present in the British area of the showfield. 2017 marks the 30th anniversary of the Range Rover's arrival in the United States; as a result, Joslin forecasts a strong turnout of classic Range Rover models at this year's event. In commemoration, the club is awarding prizes to a number of Range Rover classes that participate in the show, including one for each generation as well as 'Most Deranged Rover' and 'Best Tailgate Display'.

Having the Carlisle Fairgrounds in close vicinity to your home is a huge blessing for the car fanatic – just ask Dave Lightner of Harrisburg, who has brought his builds to the showfield almost every year since 2001. The time Lightner spent at Carlisle was influential in refining his ability to work on performance-based vehicles. Eventually, this knack for working on cars would lead him to Thaddeus Stevens College in Lancaster, PA. While attending Stevens College, Lightner started DLights Customs now known as Lightner Motorsports with two other classmates. They would go on to build multiple show-winning vehicles over the years. Lightner would later return to his alma mater as the Collision Repair Technology instructor in 2013.

Lightner's lineage of builds is an impressive one: in 2006, ESPN's TV show 'Import Racer TV' hosted by Tanner Foust followed Lightner and his team as they built a brand-new Honda Civic for the Carlisle Performance & Style show. That same car was subsequently featured in the video game 'Juiced 2: Hot Import Nights' in 2007, spotlighted with an 8-page profile in Modified Magazine, and crowned one of the top 10 builds of the decade by Fast Car Magazine. He's no stranger to SEMA either, making multiple trips out west over the years since 2004.

This year, his Gurnade/Lightner Motorsports 2017 Hyundai Veloster Turbo finally makes its way to Import & Performance Nationals after a whirlwind trip to SEMA and the Hyundai Proving Grounds in the Mojave Desert. The project began with a rendering from Austin, TX-based Gurnade, a

firm specializing in design, concepts and products for automotive & aftermarket performance brands. Dave and Josh Cloud, the founder of Gurnade, had worked together in the past on other renderings and proposals. What sets the Veloster apart from previous collaborations was their official partnership on the entire build with Lightner Motorsports, hence the 'Gurnade/Lightner Motorsports' moniker.

Making over the Veloster took about three months: delivery was in the beginning of July, and testing on Hyundai's Proving Grounds was the first week of October. To meet the deadline, Lightner credits sleepless nights, hard work from his small team of friends and his merciful father-in-law, who transported the car cross-country in three days. Although the car as a whole is near and dear to Dave, the custom fender flares created by him and his team are undeniably his favorite feature. Each flare was built from scratch, handmade with hundreds of hours into making sure they flowed perfectly with the body lines of the car. Any Veloster owner can purchase the SEMA/ Gurnade Veloster flares for their own ride at Veloster-Flares.com.
