# FEATURED VEHICLE DISPLAY: FORD GT PROTOTYPE

We are excited to share this 2009 Matech Ford GT Prototype GT1 race car with you, as it has never been on display in the U.S. at any car show until now! It is one of only two prototype Matech Ford GT1 race cars in the world. It was built by Matech Competition which was a Swiss racing team.

This vehicle has racing history behind it as well. It was in select races during the FIA GT Championship Series in 2009 as a Prototype GT1. The car did exceptionally well in various races such as Oschersleben in East Germany, Adria International Raceway, Hungaroring in Hungary and wrapping up its efforts at Paul Ricard in France. The team used this vehicle along with its sister car that Marc VDS ran along its side to learn how to improve the cars. Matech decided to build entirely new GT1 race cars for their efforts.

In the **Ford GT Tent (inside Gate 3)** we have one of the two prototype cars along with the real deal GT1 race cars that raced at Le Mans.

The Matech team focused heavily on the aerodynamics for their new GT1 cars due to the prototype lacking in this area. In 2010 when Matech launched the new GT1 race car they nailed the aero thanks to Ford's factory support which allowed the team to test the new cars in their wind tunnel to concentrate on the most efficient and effective aerodynamics. The Ford factory support really helped Matech dial in their GT1 effort in order to get the best vehicle possible for their Le Mans efforts. The all-new GT1 Matech Ford GTs did extremely well throughout the 2010 to 2012 FIA GT1 World Championship Series. In fact, the #60 Ford GT that is on display next to the prototype lead much of the race at Le Mans before it was rear-ended from behind by an LMP2 car and was taken out of the race.

We hope you enjoy seeing these two amazing Ford GT GT1 cars. Take a lot of pictures, these opportunities don't come along often.

See 40 Years of the Fox Body in Building T and the Tent on Rows IH & II to see Fox platform versions of the Mustang, Thunderbird, Cougar, Zephyr, Continental, LTD, Capri, Granada, Fairmont, Mark VII, and Marquis.

The third-generation Mustang, commonly known as the "Fox Body" or "Fox," came to market in 1979 after its Fox platform brothers the Fairmont and the Zephyr came to market in 1978. Ford wanted something so different from the previous Mustang II design that it enlisted the help of Ford designer Jack Telnack to create this all-new Ford Mustang. Through the years many versions of this Mustang would come to fruition such as the Indy Pace Edition, the Cobra, the Spring and Summer editions and more. The Fox Body would end up being the longest running body style of the Mustang to date.

# FEATURED VEHICLE DISPLAY: 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ELIMINATOR



In 1969 the Eliminator performance package appeared on a Mercury Cougar. A 351 5.8 liter four-barrel Windsor V8 engine was standard, with the 390 four-barrel V8, the 428CJ and the Boss 302 available as options. The Eliminator also featured a blacked-out grille, special side stripes, front and rear spoilers, an optional Ram Air induction system, a full gauge package including tachometer, upgraded interior trim, high-back bucket seats, rally wheels, raised white letter tires and a performancetuned suspension and handling package. In 1970 the four-barrel 351 Cleveland replaced the Windsor as the standard engine and many upgrades that were standard on the '69 were moved to the options list. See examples of both model years in Building T in our 50th Anniversary of the Eliminator display.

In 2017 Patch Hurty, then a five year old boy, found a Ford emblem along his street in Connecticut. Already a car kid, Patch was giddy with his find and since car brands were already part of his vocabulary, he knew what he had and wanted more.

Wandering streets and combing through junkyards didn't seem like the best (or safest) option to further Patch's goals, so he and his family (mom Lindsay and dad Blaine) devised a plan. They decided to reach out to major automakers via "snail mail" to find more emblems/ornaments.

It all started with a pitch that went something like this: "My name is Patch Hurty and I'm five. I love cars, I love watching them drive by my house. One time a badge fell off one and I really liked that. I like car badges and want to collect more. Could you send me one please?" Patch even included a coin from his piggy bank and a photo of him standing in front of that brand's car. He also signed each letter himself.

More than 50 letters were mailed to Ford, General Motors, Tesla, BMW ... even companies that don't exist anymore, like Saturn. The thing with standard mail is that: a) you must trust that it actually gets there; and b) wait and hope for any kind of response. Wait they did and the responses started coming.

Goodies arrived from Volvo (grille badge, frisbee), Jeep (metal sign, pen, keychain), Bentley (center cap from a wheel), BMW (a good as new emblem) and more. Lincoln, Tesla, Bugatti, Honda and Ford had some fun with Patch too. Even companies that don't sell cars anymore did a little something for him. Suzuki hasn't sold a car since 2014. but still sent stickers and a key ring, while Isuzu, who has gone carless since 2008 but does sell commercial trucks, sent some Hot Wheels of their brand. Lincoln sent an original pencil sketch of a Continental, while Ford brought the family to their world headquarters to meet with Henry Ford, III and present him with his own toy mustang.

There was also a media blitz from local, regional and national outlets. On-air and online, the Patch Hurty story was everywhere and it all started with a well-penned piece by writer Ezra Dyer of *Popular Mechanics*.

The type of responses noted above, including the special treatment from Ford, makes Patch's appearance here this weekend all the more special. Not only was it the first badge he found, it's the brand of car he wants when he gets older. On Saturday we will honor his family with a special proclamation from Carlisle Mayor Tim Scott, and the family will not only visit with the brass from Ford once more, they'll be involved in the Downtown Carlisle Parade and Street Party, too

"Carlisle Events has always been family friendly," noted company co-owner Lance Miller. "We love what we do. and our team is one big family too. We thrive on seeing future automotive generations getting excited about cars," continued Miller. "When I read the article in Popular Mechanics about Patch collecting automotive badges it really put a smile on my face. We need more children like Patch getting involved with the automotive hobby, we're excited having him join us!"

By the way, Monday is Patch's birthday. He turns 7!
