



Under the hood, the Stingray is powered by an LT1 V8 with an estimated 450 horsepower. Additional power comes from a seven-speed transmission with Active Rev Match technology. Better yet, this car fits your driving environment with Drive Mode Selector. Further, all 2014 models come standard with a carbon fiber hood and removable roof panels for coupes.

If you like those specs, you'll love this: The new Stingray provides an interior that offers genuine carbon fiber and aluminum trim, hand-wrapped leather materials, dual eight-inch configurable driver/ infotainment screens and two new seat choices, each featuring a lightweight magnesium frame for exceptional support. Along with the carbon-fiber hood, there are composite fenders, doors and rear quarter panels; carbon-nano composite underbody panels and a new aluminum frame to help shift weight rearward for an optimal 50/50 weight balance that supports a world-class power-to-weight ratio. Enjoy cruising with your top down? The Stingray convertible features a fully electronic top that can be lowered remotely using the key fob. 

Legendary Men at a Legendary Event

o name all of the special guests who have come and gone from Corvettes at Carlisle would take more space than allotted within this directory. Needless to say, there have been many, and they all have a special place within the hobby. This year, along with the annual get-together of Corvette engineers, we welcome a trio of guests who belong on an automotive Mount Rushmore, if there was such a thing. The men, available all weekend for a meet-and-greet, Q&A, autographs and more are Peter Brock, Wil Cooksey and Dave McLellan.

Brock comes back to Carlisle, where he most recently joined us in May at the Carlisle Import & Kit Nationals. He's a highly regarded designer and author in the automotive hobby and unbeknownst to most, started his career as a designer at GM Styling in 1957. Brock was the brains behind the classic forms that would eventually become the famed '63 "Split-window" Corvette Stingray, a design celebrating 50 years in 2013. Following his time with GM, Brock moved on to Shelby American in 1961. There, he designed the body for the World Championshipwinning Cobra Daytona coupe. Four years later in '65, Brock launched his own company, Brock Racing Enterprises (a.k.a. BRE). On his own with BRE, he not only was designing cars for companies such as Hino, Toyota and Triumph, he started his own race team and literally put the Japanese automotive industry into the history books with his famed team of BRE Datsuns. Those cars won two C Production National Championships with the 240Z and two 2.5 Trans-Am Championships with driver John Morton and his beloved BRE Datsun 510s. Peter Brock brings star power, an amazing résumé, and his latest book, "Corvette Stingray, Genesis of an American Icon." Grab a copy of the book here this weekend and get it autographed by the man himself!

Because listing our guests alphabetically by last name is the only way to keep things fair, Wil Cooksey is up next. Known at Carlisle for his crazy 2007 burnout, Cooksey has the record of being the longest-running Corvette plant manager in Corvette

history with 15 years on the job. During his tenure, the Corvette community saw eight Special Edition and nine Indy 500 Pace Car Corvettes, plus the introduction of the Corvette Museum Delivery Experience option for buyers of new Corvettes. With a career that started in 1972 as an assistant professor in engineering at GMI in Flint, MI, Cooksey was promoted to Plant Manager at the Bowling Green, KY Corvette assembly plant in 1993. There, he was responsible for the production of not only Corvettes, but Cadillac's Corvette-based XLR 2-seater roadster. Next week, his association with Bowling Green and Corvette comes full circle as he is inducted into the National Corvette Hall of Fame for his amazing career accomplishments.

Finally, and only because M comes after B and C, is Dave McLellan. McLellan joined the General Motors Proving Ground Noise and Vibration Lab after graduating from Wayne State University (Ohio) as a mechanical engineer. Not long after, his assignments had him working on the dynamics of cars, trucks and military tanks, then as manager of the newly completed Vehicle Dynamics Test Area. After that, he led a team that wrapped the development of the '701/2 Camaro. In '73, McLellan spent time at MIT and then returned to work with the legendary Zora Arkus-Duntov. It wasn't long after that he went from working with to taking over for Duntov following his 1975 retirement. At that point, McLellan was named Corvette Chief Engineer. For the next 17 years, McLellan and Corvette were tied at the hip. In what amounted to his last development with Corvette, McLellan helped birth the design that is forever known as the C5 Corvette. In 1992, he retired from GM and since then, he's worked as a consultant and author, including "Corvette from the Inside, the 50 Year Development History."

"Having Peter Brock and his wife, Gayle, is fitting for this year's Corvettes at Carlisle weekend," said event manager Lance Miller. "I encourage everyone to introduce yourself, as Peter and Gayle are great people with amazing stories. Wil Cooksey never needs an introduction, plus he and his wife, Liz, are out of this



Two One-of-a-Kind Classics in Building T

f you are a fan of the Corvette, you have come to the right place. Better yet, if you appreciate the history of the brand, this weekend not only has something special in store for you, it features two very, very special cars. Each car is one of one and each has a unique story. Both are from 1963 and both are part of our special 50th anniversary nod to the '63 production line.

Our first special car, appearing as part of Chip's Choice as #312, is a very rare 1963 concept car. The car, a Corvette Rondine concept, was built for the Paris Auto Show, and since its birth until at least 2008, was on display at the Pininfarina Museum in Italy. At that point, the car was sold at the famed Barrett-Jackson Scottsdale (Arizona) auto auction. What really makes this car special is that it is the only steel-bodied Corvette ever created. In addition, the car is based on the '63 Corvette chassis and has a 327-ci, 360-hp V8 under the hood. While the car won't be showcasing its power on the autocross course, it will be on display in Building T.

Joining the Rondine car will be an eye-catcher that was designed and transformed by the legendary George Barris. It is Chip's Choice #311. Specialordered new as a paint delete car by legendary speedboat racer Bob Nordskog, this '63 Corvette was delivered straight to Barris, the "King of Kustoms." The new C2 Corvette was already a fresh design from Chevrolet, and Barris made a radical transformation and redesigned the car with an extended nose cone that had headlights positioned behind the bladed grille, custom headers exiting behind the front wheels, removed the split window, filled in the rear tail panel and opened up the rear wheel wells to accommodate big wheels. The paint job was out of this world and was done in a heavy metallic copper finish that would blind you in the sunlight. This helped give the car the name

"Asteroid" since it looked like it was on fire and moving at 1,000 mph sitting still. The interior design was just as wild as the exterior and done by Don Ferrara of San Pedro, CA. It was finished in a Pearl White Naughahyde complimented with copper accents to match the exterior paint.

The Asteroid was built with dual personalities and was as fierce at the car shows as it was racing down the quarter mile. It was powered by a 352-ci motor with 13:1 compression and fed through six chrome Stromburg 97 carburetors. Everything under the hood was either painted gold metallic or chrome-plated and was the topper for an already over-the-top car. Dayton wire wheels were used for street duty and American Mags with race tires were used for track duty.

Having been featured on multiple magazine covers and earning Best of Show awards a handful of times too, the Asteroid was even on the cover of the Jan and Dean "Drag City" record. With so many awards and recognitions, this car is a must-see this weekend. Just like the Rondine, you can find it in Building T.

"For Chip's Choice we always seek the best-of-thebest, and this year is certainly no exception," said event manager Lance Miller. "The vehicles in this incredible display are the rarest of rare within the Corvette hobby and we're thankful the owners were generous enough to put them on display," he said. "Take a close look at the Asteroid paint — metallic within this paint is an absolute understatement; I can tell you prior to your seeing it that you've never seen paint like this before! The Rondine is another incredible example that we are honored to have this weekend. Just think, one of one for both of these amazing automobiles. I encourage you to take plenty of pictures because it's not often you get to see history in the making."

One of the important options that was introduced was the Z06 package. This option included heavy-duty suspension, heavy-duty metallic brakes, quick steering and a limited-slip rear end. Two other options offered was a large 36-gallon fuel tank and a fuel-injected 360 horsepower engine. All Z06 Corvettes came with the fuel-injected engine.

There were 199 Z06 Corvettes produced in 1963. Of the 199 Z06s produced, 50 cars came with the 36-gallon fuel tank. Corvettes at Carlisle is pleased to host it within Chip's Choice for all of our attendees to enjoy!

This is one of the 50 Z06 Corvettes with the 36-gallon fuel tank. The color of the car is called Sebring Silver, which was the only color offered as an option (\$80) that year.

Of course the two Garrett Turbochargers help the vehicle breathe a little better, too. This car does not run on alcohol, it doesn't use NOS, no racing fuel and runs on pump gas! Chip's Choice #317 1963 Corvette Split-Window Coupe, "Dick Lang's ZO6/ Tanker Race Car"

This fine example has been completely restored to Daytona Race Livery by the famous Nabers Brothers of Houston, TX at a cost of \$224,000. This is one of the early "Batched Built" 1963 Z06 Corvettes that went to battle against Shelby's Cobras back in 1963 and 1964, with full owner and race history including the NCRS/ GM shipping data report. Dick Lang was one of the best Corvette drivers in the late '50s and early '60s. He owned a Chevrolet dealership in Xenia, OH and raced throughout the Midwest, Central, Northeast, Southeast regions of SCCA to Regional and National status as one of the best drivers in A and B Production. On February 16-17, 1963, he raced the Daytona International weekend in two events. That weekend kicked off a series of wins or high-place podium races. Dick was 4th in 1963 and 3rd in 1964 in National SCCA A Production standings; that, added to his 1962 rank of 4th, made him one of the best drivers in the country. In '64, he was the only Corvette driver among four Cobras in the top five. Dick Lang was also given a 1965 M22/Chevrolet Engineering Corvette (one of 30) VIN 194675S116694 and a 1967 black L88 VIN 194377S122014, which was the last 1967 L88 produced. But Dick did not race in 1965, 1966, or 1967. He resumed racing in 1968 and by 1969 joined

the DeLorenzo Owens-Corning team. Dick Lang was a man's man! We're honored to have this beautiful and incredibly racy Corvette on display throughout the weekend in Chip's Choice.



Chip's Choice #318 1963 Corvette Split-Window Coupe Export RH Drive Z06 Fuelie GM Show Car

Right-hand-drive check it out, the steering wheel is on the other side of this 22,723 actual-miles example car. This vehicle has credentials to boot, it has been Bloomington Gold-certified as an original Survivor in all four categories. The car is one of 199 with the Z06 special performance equipment and this one is radio delete. This is an original motorcar per recent affirmation by CCAS, LLC/Al Grenning as to the legitimacy and originality of the cylinder case (engine block), engine stamp pad and engine stampings. This beauty has Daytona Blue paint with a Dark Blue interior which both are original examples in excellent condition.

The car was displayed in the 1963 Sydney and Melbourne Motor Shows while owned by GM. It was a Best of Show winner of the First Corvette Car Club of Australia convention in Victoria in 1980 and in their newsletter. Terry and his team are seeking information regarding this car's build and purpose by Chevrolet/ GM. They are also seeking the April 1980 Melbourne Sunday Press article concerning the Corvette convention and this Z06 Corvette. Production date of May 11, 1963, and delivered new for export to Australia (dealer code 2 in zone 21) per the official NCRS/GM Shipping Data Records (SDR). The car was recently purchased from the second owner.

Chip's Choice #319 1963 Z06 36 Tanker Corvette Racer

Owner: Larry Sachs

The car with two lives! It was once a small-block fuel-injected car that raced at Daytona and Sebring, and later used a 396 big block, as the famous "Golden Goose." The current owner, Larry Sachs and his team, decided to restore the car back to the livery when it raced at Sebring in 1965, where the team had plenty of images to work off of. This vehicle has a fruitful race



history and fit perfectly with our "Best of '63s" theme; we're thankful to have it on display throughout the weekend.

The completed restoration was done by Robert and J.R. Amantea with the paint and bodywork performed by Ray Zisa of the Corvette Center. We enlisted many consultants to help with the car - Kevin MacKay, Franz Estereicher and Steve Devoux — and the owner would like to send special thanks to them. Once the car was completed, it was reunited with one of its original drivers, John Bushell, as it was featured at the Chevy Vettefest, (now Muscle Car and Corvette Nationals). When John saw the car, it was as if he went back in time, he couldn't believe how accurately it was restored to that fateful Sebring day. He became very emotional as he saw the car, as it brought back many memories from his life; and that's when it all came together for the team as this is what the hobby is all about, sharing memories and stories and sharing in the car's history.



Chip's Choice #320 1963 FIA Sebring and Daytona Livery Owner: John Justo

This vehicle was delivered to Yenko Chevrolet in Cannonsburg, PA, in Ocober 1962 along with a sister car that was painted Daytona Blue. Grady Davis and Gulf Oil were the owners. Almost immediately, the car was shipped to Puerto Rico and entered in the November 62 Grand Prix of Caguas, where Dr. Dick Thompson won his first SCCA A/P race in the car. In January 63, the car raced the Refrigrator Bowl at Marlboro, MDn and "The Flying Dentist" repeated a win in A/P. The car then went back to Yenko's Sportscar Shop and was prepared to FIA spec by Gulf Oil's Bernie Kessler and Yenko's chief mechanic Bill Hartley. They changed the engine to the 355-ci special, added front hood vents to vacate the engine-bay heat and reduce front-end lift. They also added rear fender flares and modified front fender lips to handle the FIA larger cross-section tires that were being used at the time. Mandatory roll bar and side marking lights were added and the fuel cap was modified for quicker fuel delivery. Other modifications included the Z06

package, big tank, roll bar, added FIA mods per above.

Notes/Race History: Of all the Special 1963 Z06 race-produced Corvettes, this is the most famous as it raced and won in both A/Production and FIA configurations during the 1963 race season. In 1962, 15 special-assigned VIN number Z06 Corvettes were produced. Two of these Special Z06s, chassis number 2227 (white) and 2244 (blue), were delivered to Don Yenko for Gulf Oil. These Z06s were shipped to the Gulf Oil Facility in Pittsburgh in preparation for the Puerto Rican Grand Prix in November. In early 1963, at the Yenko Sportsman shop, both Gulf Z06s were altered to meet FIA spec in order to qualify and compete in the FIA sanctioned 12-Hour races at Daytona and Sebring. Gulf Oils Bernie Kessler and the Yenko chief mechanic Bill Hartley completed the following modifications to the car: fender flares (after Daytona) to cover six-inch-wide, knockoff aluminum wheels, Goodyear Stockcar Special racing tires, relocated and modified fuel filler and a longrange 36.5-gallon fiberglass fuel tank, added rear brake air-scoops, lightweight plexi-glass side and rear windows, a two-way radio, blacked-out gauges, roof light and a special vented hood designed to minimize front-end lift. Headlamp raising, lowering motors and assorted brackets were disposed of, further decreasing weight. Under the ownership of Gulf Oil and supervision of Grady Davis, the great Dr. Dick Thompson, nicknamed "The Flying Dentist," piloted the white Gulf One Z06 to an impressive race history. At Puerto Rican Grand Prix the Z06 was driven by Dr. Dick Thompson and placed First in SCCA A/P Class. In January '63, the car raced at the Refrigerator Bowl in Marlboro, MD. The Flying Dentist repeated a win in A/P. At the Daytona Continental FIA Race, Dick Thompson placed a very credible third place. At the March Sebring, the USA major international endurance FIA race of that time. Thompson was one of seven new Corvette entries. DNF due to transmission failure. At Marlboro, during the SCCA President Cup races in May, the Gulf One placed first with Dick Thompson piloting. At the VIR Danville, Virginia, for the A Production race, Thompson finished 3rd, even with some minor body damage to the RF (see photo). The June Sprints at Road America at Elkhart Lake followed, and Thompson finished 3rd. At Cumberland, MD, Thompson was 3rd again. At Bridgehampton in July, Thompson moved up to 2nd-place finish. At the season's conclusion, the Dr. Dick Thompson Z06 Corvette had won the 1963 A Production Championship. Ed Lowthar drove the car once after the '63 season. Following its Gulf Oil racing career, the Gulf One Z06 was purchased by Doc Blatchley, who continued to race the Z06. Blatchley sold it to Robert Bienerth in 1973. Donald Pulver bought it almost immediately from Don. In 1991, well-known collector Rich Mason purchased the Z06. It remained very complete and in largely undisturbed condition. Mason contributed an enormous amount of effort in making sure the Z06 was accurately restored and accepted as the genuine Gulf #1 Corvette driven by Dick Thompson. The Gulf One had a legendary journey of owners. The vehicle nestled into the homes of prominent collectors such as Harry Yeaggy, Richard Berry, Dana Mecum and John Justo.

Chip's Choice #321 1963 Split-Window Black Widow LS9 Owner: Rod & Tina Saboury

Starting with just a bare original body shell that was purchased at Corvettes at Carlisle in 2011, Rod and Tina Saboury, with the help of Legacy Innovations in York, PA, made "The Black Widow" Corvette come to life. Incorporating a new ZR1 Corvette engine, 6-speed transmission, nine-inch Ford sheet-metal rear, reverseopening hood, stainless steel fender-well headers (that exit the front fenders), Vintage air, push-button start, remote door locks, beadlock wheels, custom Mickey Thompson Redline tires and much more, this car has enough tricks to make Penn and Teller jealous. It's just over the top! Featuring a tube RSE (Rod Saboury Edition) chassis custom built by Legacy, this car is a show stopper that can easily make its way down the drag strip. Rod and Tina are World Champion drag racers who have a passion for the quarter-mile and would like to have the first ZR1-powered car in the 8s. Don't bet against them!



Chip's Choice #322 The Mickey Thompson 1963 Corvette Racer Owner: Tom McIntyre

The Mickey Thompson Corvette is one of six 1963 Z06 Stingrays built late in 1962 to race at Riverside in October. This car, and one like it, never saw Riverside. They were destined to compete in a different sort of race for sports cars, a NASCAR-sanctioned event on the famous Daytona Oval. This meant the cars needed to be prepared to a different set of rules, the same as those for the big Grand National stock cars. The chassis was modified extensively, and an experimental 427 engine was installed. The car was lightened in every way possible and weighed just over 2,800 pounds. Extra fuel was carried in a specially fabricated tank occupying the area behind the driver. Driven by Junior Johnson, this special car was the fastest qualifier at over 162 mph. Plagued by rain in the race, substitute driver Billy Krause finished 3rd behind Paul

Goldsmith's Pontiac and A.J. Foyt in another Corvette.

Special features of the Mickey Thompson NASCAR Corvette include special 427 engine, adjustable front sway bar, 3-speed transmission, adjustable rear suspension, magnesium differential, flat aluminum floors, two shocks per wheel, special exhaust system, special axles, lightweight fiberglass seats, four-wheel disc brakes, 50-gallon gas tank, engine oil cooler, plexiglas windows, differential oil cooler, full roll cage, fully welded frame and aluminum instrument panel.

After Daytona, the Mickey Thompson Corvette was returned to California, where the 427 engine was removed, and the car was sold to a Southern California road racer. A 327 engine was installed and the car was driven again by Billy Krause in the Los Angeles Times Grand Prix in October 1963.

In 1976, Tom McIntyre purchased the car and began the slow process of figuring out exactly what it was. Years later, Chevrolet engineers divulged that the car was originally powered by an experimental 427 Mk II "Mystery Motor." Thanks to Smokey Yunick, the Mickey Thompson Corvette and its special engine have been reunited.

The car has been raced across the country in historic events since 1983.














SHINODA'S LAST INTERVIEW

Shinoda's Last Interview

November 13 will be the 15th anniversary of Larry Shinoda's death. Shinoda was the styling genius responsible for the 1963 Split-Window coupe as well as other concept and production Corvettes. My wife, Liz, and I had dinner with him at the California Café during Corvettes at Carlisle in 1997. I was the last journalist to interview him before he died.

T: Let's start by getting a little background information on you, Larry. You started developing your artistic talents in grammar school, continued through high school and then attended and graduated the Art Center College of Design in Los Angeles; is that correct?

L: No, I didn't graduate — I was kicked out. They told me I didn't fit in there; my ideas and desires weren't consistent with their expectations, so I was construed as a malcontent — which, in truth, I was.

T: Let's jump ahead to your years at GM. When did you start there?

L: In September of 1956 I came onboard at GM as a senior designer.

T: That's not too shabby for someone who had gotten kicked out of art college only a couple of years prior to that.

L: Yeah, I was doing okay. But you have to understand that I was basically pretty much self-taught. What I didn't know, I picked up from other designers and I never got to the point of doing real fancy illustrations.

T: Was Bill Mitchell your immediate boss when you went to GM as a senior designer?

L: No, they put me into an orientation class that was supposed to last six months, but I was only in there a couple of weeks. Then I went to work in the Chevrolet studio. Apparently I had designed a car I guess they really liked while in the class. They took my drawing and hung it up on a Friday, I came back on Monday and it was gone. Then they told me I was being transferred to the Chevrolet studio. When I rolled my tabaret into the Chevrolet studio, my drawing was on an easel and they were modeling the damn thing full-size, so I was really kind of shocked.

T: Was it a concept car?

L: Yeah, it was kind of a concept car. They were getting ready to do the '59s, which were intended to have a bolder look than the '58s, which were already done.

T: Are you the guy responsible for the outrageous fins the '59 Chevy had?

L: Yes, pretty much so, but the fins I had originally designed didn't have that bird shape to them — it was basically a straight V-shape.

T: So now you had Mitchell's attention and he knew who you were.

L: Yeah, he knew who I was. So he recruited me to work on the Sting Ray sports race car. This was 1958, by the way. Pete Brock and a guy named Chuck Pohlmann had actually done the theme drawings and the first model of the Sting Ray. Then I was given the model and told that we had to change it so that it would fit on the SS chassis, because Mitchell had purchased a spare Corvette SS chassis. It wasn't a complete redesign, but we did have to chop and stretch, shorten and so forth. But it all worked.

T: Were the hideaway headlights and split rear window already evolving at this point?

L: No, the Sting Ray sports race car was a roadster, with the headlights mounted behind the grille. The split-window design came later when we started working on the '63 Corvette as a coupe model, but this car was the basis for it. When we did the coupe, the roof line was higher and we had to work the headlights up — it was a fairly major job of restyling from the sports race car to the production coupe, and I was the only designer in the studio working exclusively under Bill Mitchell's direction.

T: Were you still working out of the Chevrolet styling studio, or had you already migrated to Mitchell's secret Studio X?

L: All of this stuff was being done in Studio X.

T: Where exactly was Studio X located — rumors had it underneath Mitchell's office, is that right?

L: No, it was underneath the front lobby. It was a fairly small studio, but it had big doors so you could move models in and out.

T: So how secret was Studio X in reality?

L: Well, people like Chuck Jordan had a key, but he was told to stay out. Chuck Jordan was, at one time, the director of design. I don't think Mitchell liked him very much.

T: So it sounds like it wasn't the best-kept secret at GM Styling.

L: Most people knew what it was, but very few were invited in.

T: Rumor also has it that Mitchell was not the easiest guy to work for; any truth to that?

L: No, I never found that to be true. He was always easy to work with as far as I was concerned. I was able

to talk him into certain things, but then there were times when he wouldn't budge on some things. There were occasions, however, when he would put everyone in their place with a statement like, "Don't flatter yourself, kid — I'm the one who does Corvettes here." That was one of his favorite jibes.

T: Did the whole split-window idea originate with Mitchell?

L: Yeah, kind of, but it wasn't anything new, you know. There was a car that Art Ross had done; it was an Oldsmobile we called the Brass Rocket, that also had a split windows with a fin running down the middle. And there were a lot of other cars that were done with split windows, so it wasn't anything that outrageous or new.

T: Be that as it may, the split window on the '63 coupe made it the most identifiable Corvette ever made. Would you say that's an accurate statement?

L: Yeah, but it was kind of an afterthought when they cut it out for the '64 model.

T: One of the automotive publications referred to you as "Bill Mitchell's private designer." Did he always like your ideas, or were there some that fell by the wayside?

L: I can only recall one time that I went too far, and that was when we were doing the Shark. The '63 Corvette was all finished, and they needed something to ballyhoo the Corvette. So they took a '61 Corvette as the basis of the car they would call the Shark, but it had to be outrageous. So what we had here was an exaggerated '63, but on the earlier '61 chassis. To make it look more shark-like, I designed a grille that looked like it had teeth that interlocked. They were really straight pieces, but they were set in so that when you looked at it from the front, they appeared to be really pointy even though they weren't. I was pretty happy with how the wood mockup looked, so we went to a clay model, and Mitchell came into the studio and saw it. "Whoa, you guys deliberately made it look like a fish," he said, "What are you trying to do — get me fired?" That was the first time he ever said "ouch" and the only time he ever told me I overdid it.


T: While you were working on the concepts for the Sting Ray Split-Window coupe, did you have any idea how important this car would be and what effect it would have on the automotive world?

L: I knew it would be an important car, but I had no idea of the scope of how important it was going to be. I really fought for the hidden headlights, and I wanted to make it sleek and a lot more aerodynamic.

As our after-dinner coffee was being served, I asked Larry if there was anything further he'd like to say about his days at GM in Studio X, and he responded, "Of all the Corvettes, I guess the '63 Corvette is probably one of my prouder jobs."

Larry passed away of a heart attack while working in his home on November 13, 1997.
