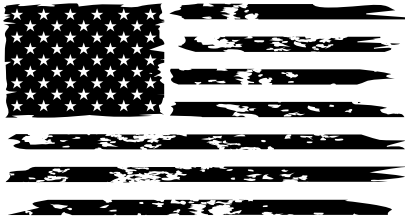


BACK IN 1974

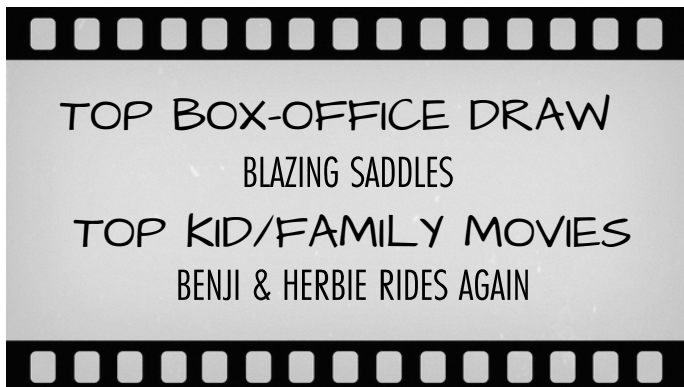
