

Celebrating 50 Years of Carlisle Events at Carlisle Import & Performance Nationals 2024

The first Carlisle Import Auto Festival & Food Fair was introduced in 1986 (May 15-18) as "an automotive United Nations of exotic, historic, economy and commercial vehicles held in an atmosphere of international food and festivities". Kit cars and replicars were invited to join in 1992 and with that came a name change to Carlisle Import/Kit-Replicar Nationals. Custom compacts ("foreign and domestic, chopped, dropped, slammed and tweaked") were added in 1996 and became a show within a show with its own name in 1997, Custom Compact Power Jam. That genre exploded and was a huge standalone event from 2001 to 2003 with a name change to the Carlisle Custom Compact Nationals in 2002. Then in 2004, it multiplied and became two events in two locations (Harrisburg, PA and Norwalk, OH). In 2005, it was called Modified Madness and was held in State College, PA. Carlisle welcomed the event back in 2006 as Carlisle Performance & Style. In 2010, the original import event was renamed Carlisle Import & Kit Nationals. The two events were held separately through 2015, and in 2016 they rejoined as a united show under the current name of Carlisle Import & Performance Nationals.















About Carlisle Import & Performance Nationals

- For the first three years, show cars were judged by participant choice on Saturday with those winners being judged on Sunday to determine the grand prize winner who received 500 silver dollars in a trophy bowl.
- Brad Nauss has attended every Import show with the same Citroën since 1986.
- Clubs quickly started holding their meets during the event and many still do.
- Drag racing took place at the South Mountain Dragway Friday night of the event from 1986 through 1994.
- Changes in 1989 included giving goody bags and dash plaques to the first 300 show cars, a beauty contest, and volleyball.
- Irv Gordon brought his One Million Miles Volvo in 1990; returning in 2007 with 2.5 million; and in 2021 it was here with 3.26 million miles.
- In 1992, an organized scenic cruise, remote control competition, free expert seminars, and drive-in style movie were introduced.
- Students in the auto mechanics program at nearby Carlisle Area High School completed the build of a Cobra kit car that was given away at the 1994 event.
- The Carlisle Steelyard, a platform on which to balance a vehicle, was added in 1995.
- With the addition of custom compacts in 1996 came a stereo competition.

- The first Carlisle Burnout Contest was held in front of a packed grandstand in 2001 at CCPJ.
- The track was first used for autocross at the Import show in 2002. Drifting was added in 2007 at P&S. The drift limbo began in 2018, and the burnout contest moved to the track in 2023 and includes donuts.
- The ICE House was a display that started at the 2006 P&S event that featured vehicles with custom in-car-entertainment (ICE).
- Custom compact builders, Neil Tjin and RJ de Vera were featured at P&S in 2007.
- Bruce Meyers, creator of the fiberglass dune buggy, the Meyers Manx, visited the Import show several times beginning in 2008.
- Formula Drift champion Vaughn Gittin Jr. was a featured guest in 2011 at P&S.
- The Passport program was introduced in 2011 at the Import show and continues today. The prizes were pins featuring the flag of a different country through 2017 and have been pint glasses featuring the t-shirt design since 2018.
- Peter Brock, of the Datsun racing team BRE, designer of the Cobra Daytona Coupe and '63 Split-Window Corvette, was a special guest at the Import show in 2013.
- The Low Car Limbo contest was introduced in 2013 at P&S and the Rolling Exhaust contest in 2015.
