

Spectator Rules

Events held at the Carlisle PA Fairgrounds Updated January 2024. This document supercedes all previous versions.

1. REFUNDS

a. No refunds are issued within 45 days of the event.

b. Events take place rain or shine.

2. TICKETS

- a. Lost or stolen Season Passes will not be reissued.
- b. Re-admission is allowed on the same day with a hand stamp and punched ticket from the day's entry.

3. RESPECT THE VENUE

- a. Follow all posted rules and guidelines provided by Carlisle Events.
- b. Stay within designated spectator areas and respect any restricted zones.
- c. Use designated trash bins for disposal of waste.
- d. Open fire pits and fires are prohibited.
- e. Drones are not authorized on or near the facility.

4. SPECTATOR CONDUCT

- a. All participants must conduct themselves appropriately, respecting the inclusive and diverse community.
- b. Discrimination, harassment, bullying, xenophobia, racism, or any form of harassment is not tolerated.
- c. Zero tolerance policy on disruptive behavior. Offenders will be removed from the event.
- d. Keep noise levels reasonable. No offensive music. Generators must be turned off overnight.
- e. Respect personal space of fellow spectators.
- f. Avoid disruptive behavior that may impact others' enjoyment of the event.

5. PROHIBITED BEHAVIORS

- a. No drunkenness, public nudity, burnouts, recklessness, foul language, offensive clothing, or disruptive actions.
- b. Security and event staff are authorized to ensure a safe and enjoyable environment.
- c. Management reserves the right to eject a participant for inappropriate conduct.

6. DRIVING ON-GROUNDS

- a. Vehicles must remain parked from arrival to departure.
- b. No cruising, burnouts, or use of unauthorized vehicles (side-by-sides, ATV's, scooters, dirt bikes, etc.)
- c. Personal mobility scooters are permitted.
- d. Golf carts must be preregistered call Customer Service at 717-243-7855 for more information.

7. SEATING AND STANDING

- a. Use designated seating areas grandstand, benches, food court to avoid blocking walkways.
- b. Do not stand on seats or any structures that are not intended for standing.

8. CHILDREN AND PETS

- a. Always keep children under supervision.
- b. Service animals are permitted.
- c. Pets are allowed but must remain on a leash, you must clean up after your pet, provide with necessities and under control. You are responsible for your pet. No pets permitted in the food court.

9. SAFETY AND LIABILITY

- a. Spectator parking is at your own risk.
- b. Carlisle Events does not guarantee the safety of property left on-site or off-site.
- c. Obey all local laws and regulations while attending the event.
- d. Report any concerns or issues to event staff or security personnel.

10.NO SMOKING AREAS

- a. Respect designated no-smoking areas.
- b. Dispose of cigarette butts in designated containers.
- c. No smoking in the Food Court, seating areas, or concession stands.

11. FIRST AID/EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

- a. First Aid is located next to Guest Services, or you can call Security at 717-960-6429.
- b. Report injuries or emergencies promptly.
- c. Security is located inside Gate 3.
- d. Follow instructions from event staff and emergency personnel.

12. PHOTOGRAPHY AND RECORDING

- a. Follow any event policies regarding photography and recording.
- b. By attending, individuals grant Carlisle Events the right to use images and likeness for various purposes.

13. LIABILITY WAIVER

- a. Participants acknowledge the risks associated with the event and release organizers from liability.
- b. Attendees are expected to read and understand the rules, acknowledging that Carlisle Events relies on this agreement.

By attending the event, spectators agree to abide by these rules and guidelines. Carlisle Events reserves the right to enforce these rules for the safety and enjoyment of all participants.
